Essay Layout

- <u>Introduction:</u> The argument stating that "conclusion" is not logically sound. The errors lying in the premise(s) and conclusion are the following: 1-----, 2------ and 3--
- <u>Body 1:</u> One error/First, state error 1. Explain it with respect to the context. Then, suggest a solution.
- <u>Body 2:</u> Another error/second, state error 2. Explain it with respect to the context and then suggest a solution.
- <u>Body 3:</u> Finally,/Third, state error 3. Explain it and suggest a solution.
- <u>Conclusion:</u> Thus, restate errors. Restate solutions

Logical Flaws

- 2. Weak analogy
- 3. Generalization
- 4. Confusing cause effect with time correlation
- 5. Assuming both courses of action are mutually exclusive

Logical Flaws

- 6. Unreliable study
- 7. Unrepresentative statistics
- 8. Assuming that people/issues remain the same over time.
- 9. Assuming there is only one factor leading to a certain outcome.
