## Interactive Speaking Self-Check

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**CEFR Progression: Mid-B2 → B2+ (emerging C1)**

Interactive speaking means talking with classmates in real conversations, discussions, and tasks — not prepared presentations.

- I developed my arguments with clear reasoning.
- I used discourse markers effectively (however, in contrast).
- I used appropriate vocabulary and phrases to communicate my ideas.

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## Prepared Speaking Self-Check

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**CEFR Progression: Mid-B2 → B2+ (emerging C1)**

Prepared speaking means you have time to plan and rehearse before you speak — a mini-talk, presentation, or structured explanation.

- I delivered a fluent and well-organized presentation.
- I used advanced discourse markers (however, in contrast, moreover).
- I developed arguments with clear reasoning.
- My grammar and vocabulary were precise and flexible.
- My delivery was polished and engaging.

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## Writing Self-Check

### CEFR Progression: Mid-B2 → B2+ (emerging C1)

Writing tasks are short and purposeful — usually 30–150 words. Focus on communicating your message clearly.

- My ideas are organized with clear discourse markers (however, in contrast, moreover).
- My writing is coherent and extended.
- I used a wide range of vocabulary and grammar.
- My message and purpose are consistently clear.
- I checked for accuracy and precision.

★★★	I arrived on time or with only a brief delay. I took part in most activities. I responded when the teacher asked me questions. I used English most of the time but sometimes used my first language.
★★	I arrived late or left early. I was present but missed some activities or was not always focused. I usually only spoke when asked. I used English sometimes but often used my first language.
★	I arrived significantly late or left well before the end. I was present but did not really take part. I rarely responded or contributed. I did not use English much during the lesson.

★★★★	I joined on time or with only a very brief delay. My camera was on for the full session with only minor brief gaps. I took part in all activities and stayed on task throughout. I used English during the lesson, though I sometimes used other languages in breakout sessions.
★★★	I joined late or left early, missing part of the session. My camera was on for most of the session with some gaps. I took part in most but not all activities. I responded when prompted but rarely contributed on my own. I used English inconsistently, often relying on other languages even when English was expected.
★	I joined significantly late or disconnected well before the session ended. My camera was off or on only briefly. I had limited engagement throughout. I contributed only once or twice. I almost never used English during activities.
