

Make / do take / get

These verbs are 'hot' because they are very common and have many different collocations (groupings).

Use:

Make – when there is an idea of creativity – "make a cake"

Do – when there is an idea of work - "do my homework"

Take – collocates with time, medicine and photos.

Get – can mean 'arrive at', 'receive' and 'become' (when there is a sense of change from one state to another).
