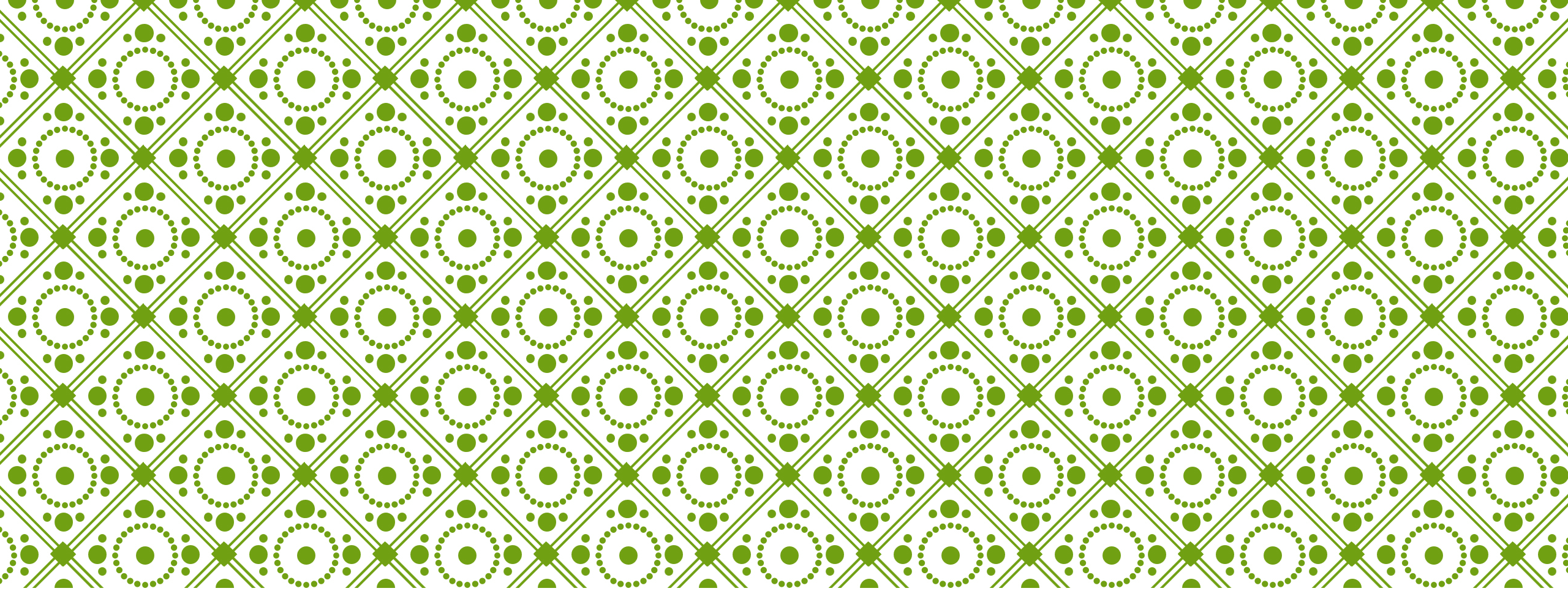
WHAT WOULD YOU DO IN THESE SITUATIONS?

Example: Fact: I don't speak English fluently (wish)

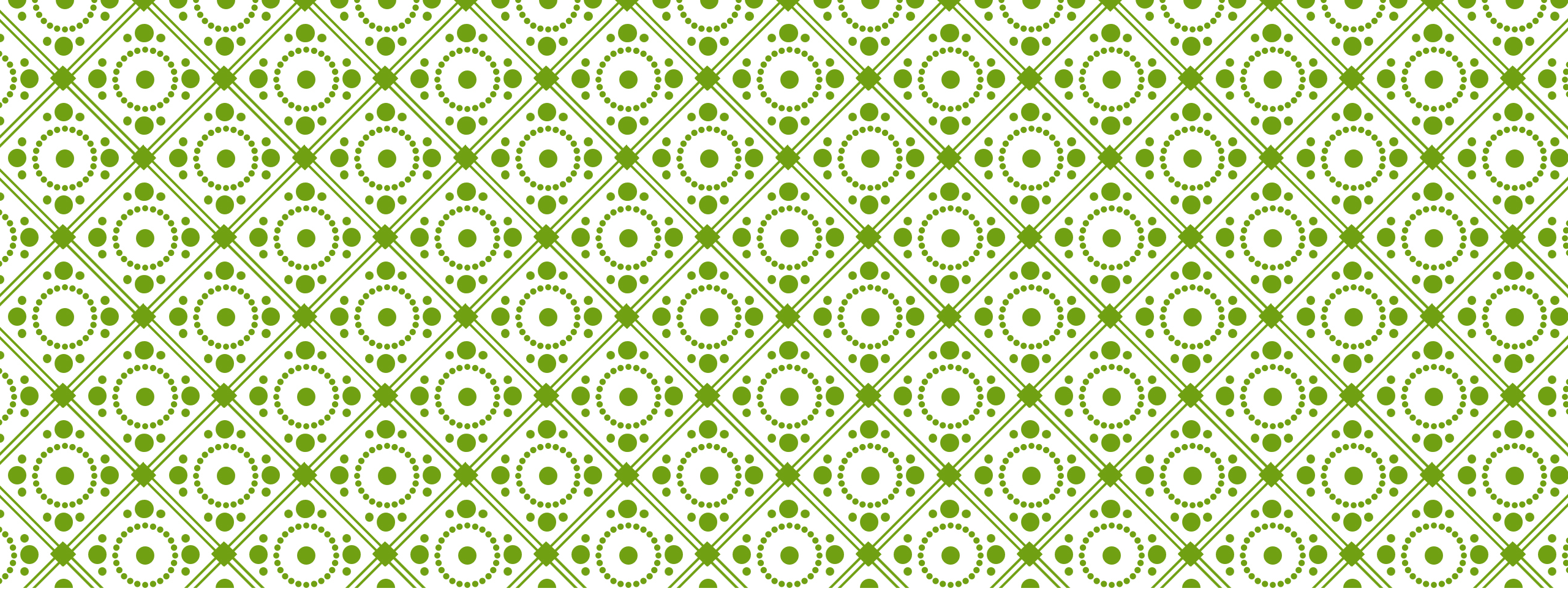
Hypothesis: I wish I spoke English fluently.

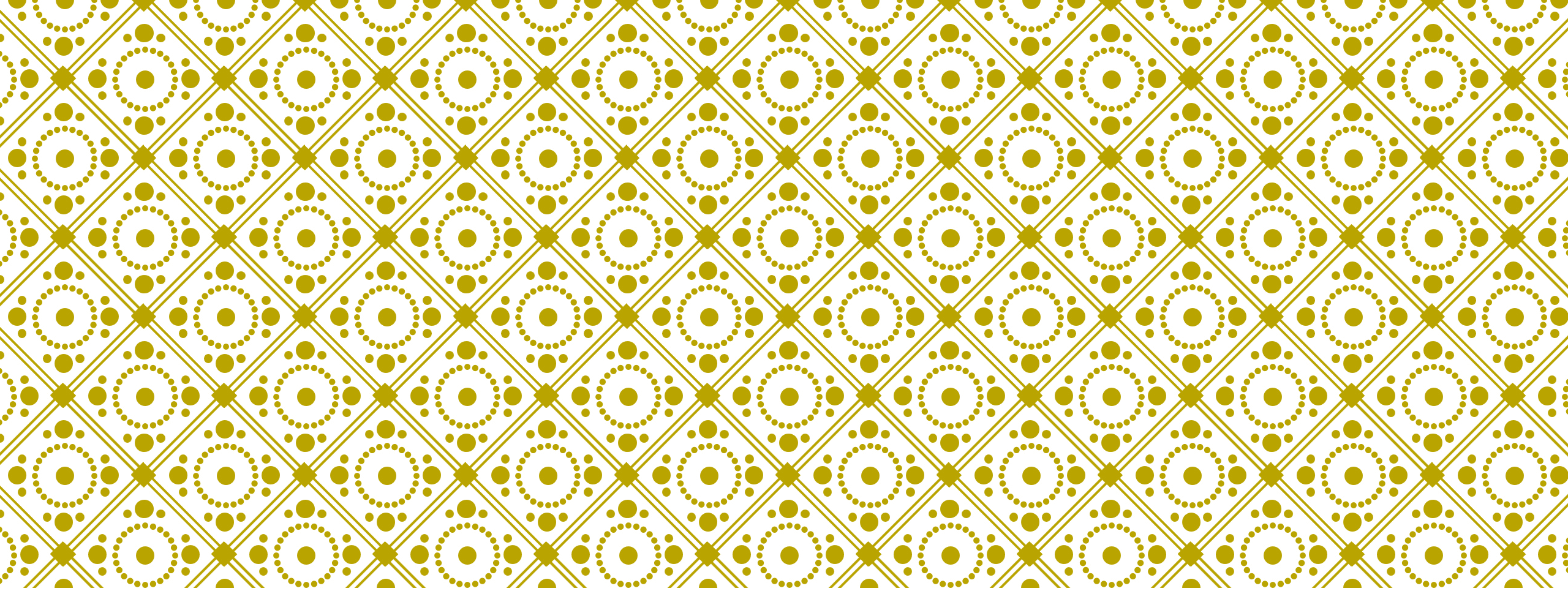
