Life in the village of Polessye

The nuclear disaster changed the lives of everybody in the village. It took away all the hope for the future. However, when Palina was born in 1988 her parents did their best to give her and her brother a good life. By the time she went home, Palina could speak a few words of English and was very happy when the Quaids invited her back. After, she started to visit the family twice a year and often spent three months with them in summer.
