Passive Voice Table with Examples

Tense	Active Voice Example	Passive Voice Example
Present Simple	She writes a letter.	A letter is written by her.
Past Simple	He cleaned the room.	The room was cleaned by him.
Future Simple	They will finish the project.	The project will be finished by them.
Present Continuous	She is reading a book.	A book is being read by her.
Past Continuous	He was repairing the car.	The car was being repaired by him.
Present Perfect	They have completed the task.	The task has been completed by them.
Past Perfect	She had written the report.	The report had been written by her.
Future Perfect	He will have done the work.	The work will have been done by him.
Modal (can)	She can solve the problem.	The problem can be solved by her.
Modal (must)	They must finish the job.	The job must be finished by them.

Notes:

- The passive voice is formed by using the verb "to be" + past participle of the main verb.
- The agent (doer of the action) is often introduced by "by," but it can be omitted if unknown or unimportant.
