When to use "will" and when to use "present continuous" for future events ?

Tense	Structure	Usage	Examples
Future Simple	Will + Verb/ Will + not + verb (won't)	make offers	I 'll see you tomorrow.
		make promises	Mary will help with the cooking.
Present continuous	Is/are/am + verb + ing	to talk about plans	/ `m <i>meeting</i> John <i>at work today</i> .
Present continuous " going to"	Is/are/am + going to + verb	Talk about intentions/ plans made from before	 They are going to move to Manchester. I'm going to drive to work today.
