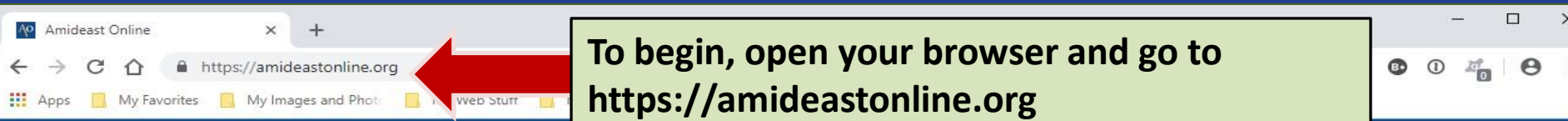
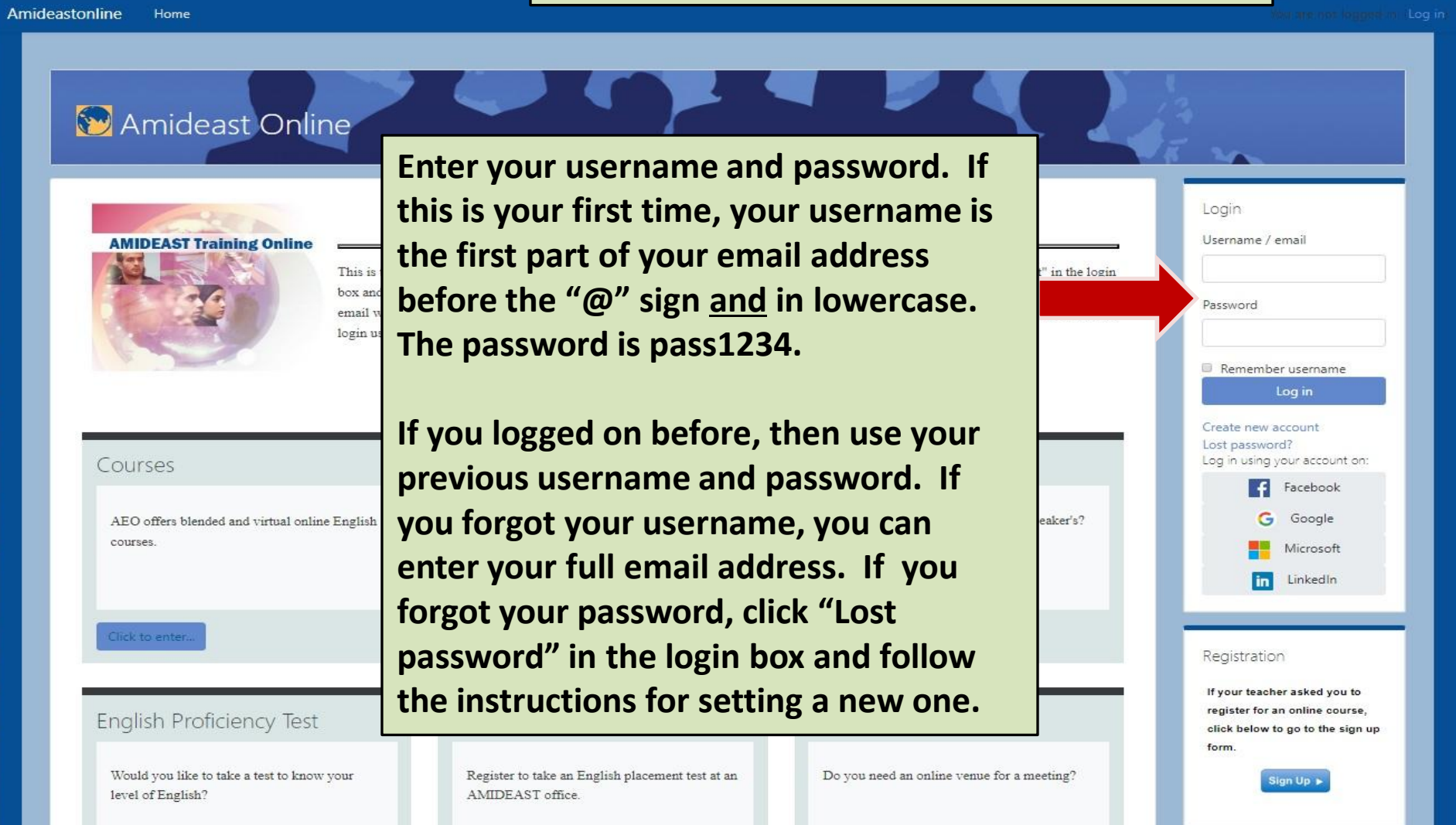


Instructions for Logging on to the AMIDEAST Online LMS

if you are not sure about something.



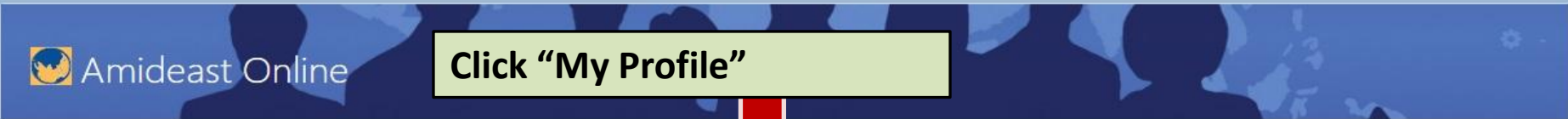
To begin, open your browser and go to <https://amideastonline.org>



Enter your username and password. If this is your first time, your username is the first part of your email address before the “@” sign and in lowercase. The password is pass1234.

If you logged on before, then use your previous username and password. If you forgot your username, you can enter your full email address. If you forgot your password, click “Lost password” in the login box and follow the instructions for setting a new one.
