Oprah the TV star

In 1984 Oprah (1) moved to Chicago to work on a TV talk show called A.M. Chicago. She (2) talked to lots of interesting people about their problems. Oprah says, "People's problems are my problems." The show was very successful, so in 1985 it was renamed *The Oprah Winfrey Show*. In 1993 she (3) interviewed Michael Jackson and 100 million people (4) watched the program. Last year she (5) earned \$260,000,000.



In 1998 Oprah (6) started the charity Oprah's Angel Network. This helps poor children all over the world.
