predictions (we think something will happen)

- He will be a good doctor.
- I believe they will win this match.

instant decisions (taken while speaking)

A: "We don't have sugar"
B: "I'll buy some then."

#### promises and refusals

I will help you but I won't lend you any money.

#### offers

I'll carry your bag. / Shall I carry your bag?

suggestions

Shall we eat out today?

#### requests

Will you open the door please? predictions (we see present evidence)

- Slow down! We're going to have an accident!
- Look at the clouds. It's going to rain.

decisions (taken before now – intentions/plans)

Are you going to watch the game tonight?

# present continuous

plans (arrangements have been made)

- I'm flying to New York tomorrow morning.
- I'm seeing the dentist at
   6.
- We are getting married next week.

### When to use "will" and when to use "present continuous" for future events?

Tense	Structure	Usage	Examples
Future Simple	Will + Verb/ Will + not + verb ( won't)	make offers	l' <b>ll see</b> you tomorrow.
		make promises	Mary <b>will help</b> with the cooking.
Present continuous	Is/are/am + verb + ing	to talk about <b>plans</b>	/ <b>ˈm <i>meeting</i></b> John <i>at work</i> <i>today.</i>
Present continuous " going to"	Is/are/am + going to + verb	Talk about intentions/ plans made from before	- They <b>are going to move</b> to Manchester. - I <b>'m going to drive</b> to work today.
