

Answers

- Anywhere between 40 days to nine and half months, it depends on the position of the planets.
- It is a machine used by NASA to extract oxygen from carbon dioxide, it could also provide us with liquid oxygen propellant.
- We'd use hydroponics cultivating your crops in a mineral and nutrient soil, where no soil is required. A major obstacle would be no running water which would only allow us to produce 20% of food we'll need.
- We would probably live underground, inflatable pressurized buildings.
- Temperatures on Mars are very low as low as 55 degrees below zero or even colder at the poles it could drop to -153 degrees.
- Time is slower on Mars, Mars is just 40 minutes longer than a day on Earth.
- You would have 7 months of Spring, 6 months of summer, 5 months of autumn, and 4 months of winter.
- They would clog up all your electronics.
- They would extract the water ice caps, which would lead to water vapor causing rain and perhaps snow.
