Documentary Story Presentation

You will prepare and deliver a **documentary-style story presentation**. Your presentation should tell a **real, factual story** in an engaging and structured way, similar to a short documentary.

1. Topic

Choose **one real documentary story**. It can be about:

- A real person (famous or unknown)
- A real event (historical, social, environmental, cultural)
- A real place
- A real social issue or phenomenon

The story **must be real**, not fictional.

2. Presentation Length

• 5–7 minutes per presentation

3. Content Requirements

Your documentary story should include:

1. Introduction

- o Introduce the topic clearly
- o Explain what the story is about and why it is important

2. Background / Context

- o Give key facts (who, what, where, when)
- Provide relevant historical or social background

3. Main Story

- o Tell the story in a logical order
- o Describe key moments, events, or developments
- o Use clear transitions (e.g. At first..., Later..., As a result...)

4. Impact or Message

- o Explain the consequences or significance of the story
- o What did this story change, reveal, or teach?

5. Conclusion

- Summarise the main points
- o Share your final reflection or message to the audience

4. Visual Support

You may use:

- PowerPoint / Google Slides
- Images, short video clips, or maps

Slides should support your speech, not replace it

5. Sources

- Use at least one reliable source
- Be ready to mention where your information comes from (e.g. documentary, article, website)

6. Important Notes

- Practice before presenting
- Be prepared to answer **1–2 questions** from the audience
